There was no deputy report but Buchanan County Sheriff's Department logged about 28 hours of service in August. Public Works Director reported DNR Wastewater Survey was completed and street work is done. Fire Chief, Terry Crow, reported the department had 1 grass fire and 3 medical calls since last meeting. Mayor Cook was unable to attend the BCEDC meeting.

Mayor Cook reported on a recent law change from City Attorney that became effective July 1, 2024 where lowa Code § 21.8 requires that a governmental body provide for electronic meeting options for members of the governmental body. The governmental body should utilize the electronic meeting method(s) that allows for participation of members of the governmental body while also ensuring the meeting meets lowa Code chapter 21 requirements. The new law does not change existing

requirements as it relates to public access to the meeting and compliance with public notice requirements. City Attorney will be proceeding via publication with 657A. 10B action regarding property located at 315 Church Street. Mayor Cook will be contacting the owner of vacant properties for an update. He continues to work with property owners on nuisance abatement properties.

Motion by Lincoln, second by Adams to approve Resolution 24-24 certifying delinquent city service bills to property taxes for collection. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Lincoln, second by Slack to accept Origin Design, formerly IIW, proposal for \$1500.00 for Bridge Inspection Services. All ayes; motion carried as Resolution 24-25.

Motion by Slack, second by Lamphier to approve the second reading of Ordinance #113 Amending Chapter 155 – Restricted Residence District. Ayes: Adams, Devlin, Lincoln, Lamphier & Slack. Second reading was approved.
